## Any questions about the activities? Read on!

**READ a wordless book.** → As long as there are no words or very few, it counts.

**WATCH a movie with subtitles.** → You can watch a movie in English with subtitles turned on, or a movie in another language with subtitles. You could even count watching episodes of (subbed!) television.

**READ a new book (published in 2021-22).** → Just as it says! Publication dates are usually at the beginning of a book, under 'copyright'.

WRITE a short story/poem/other piece. → Write whatever you like! If you'd like to submit it to us, we'll put the best ones online, but you don't have to! Email <a href="mailto:swantonpl@gmail.com">swantonpl@gmail.com</a> if you're interested.

PARTICIPATE in the library's summer scavenger hunt. → The scavenger hunt entry form can also be found here: <a href="https://swantonpubliclibrary.org/scavenger">https://swantonpubliclibrary.org/scavenger</a>. Participating in the hunt gets its own prize! READ an older book (published before 2000!). → Publication dates are at the beginning of a book.

**ATTEND either Pirate Training or Mysteries at Sea at the library.** → *Pirate Training*: Meet Captain Book and the crew of the SPL; be here at 4:00 pm on June 16! *Mysteries at Sea*: Go on an archaeological dig and learn about sunken cities and other mysteries at 4:00 pm on June 28.

**LISTEN to an audiobook. (Short ones count!)** → Any audiobook of any length counts! If needed, the library has a collection of picture books paired with an audio reading, usually about half an hour long.

**READ** a book that became a movie.  $\rightarrow$  A lot of movies now were books first! Read any of them.

WATCH the *Moana* interactive movie. Grab a kit from the library! → The kit will include a copy of *Moana* and some treats and activities to do while watching. Make sure to return the movie! **WATCH** a movie that was a book first. → There are a lot of them out there! Watch any one you like. **REREAD** your favorite book. → Any of your favorites will do!

**DRAW your favorite mythological sea creature.** → Draw your favorite imaginary ocean creature (you can draw a real one too if you want!). Email your picture to <a href="mailto:swantonpl@gmail.com">swantonpl@gmail.com</a> if you're interested in sharing.

**READ to someone OR have someone read to you.** → Reading to a pet counts too!
