- **READ a new book (published in 2024-25).** → Just as it says! Publication dates are usually at the beginning of a book, under 'copyright'.
- WRITE a short story/poem/other piece. → Write whatever you like! If you'd like to submit it to us, we'll put the best ones online, but you don't have to! Email swantonpl@gmail.com if you're interested.
- PARTICIPATE in the library's summer scavenger hunt. → The scavenger hunt entry form is in the registration bag and can also be found here: https://swantonpubliclibrary.org/scavenger. Participating in the hunt gets its own prize!
- **READ a book from the 1900s (or earlier!).** → Publication dates are at the beginning of a book.
- **ATTEND any of the Family Art Hubs.** → Every Wednesday at 11:00 am through July 23, when a Bob Ross painter, Nate Miller from Extravagant Works Studios, will demonstrate the technique!
